Dear Families:

The Helix Instrumental Music Association (HIMA) would like to welcome you to the 2019 – 2020 school year! The Helix Instrumental Music Program is known for its quality programs, but to maintain our standard of excellence, we must ask our families and community for financial support. **Annual operating costs for a program of our size and quality are estimated at approximately \$150,000.**

Because of state budget cuts, the school is unable to provide the necessary funds it takes to provide a quality music program. That's where HIMA comes in: we try to help secure the financial support that is needed to run our program.

This year, we anticipate the average cost for a student in Bagpipes to be \$275–\$300.

These figures represent the difference between what the school provides and the actual costs to maintain and build our current program; we estimate a \$100,000 budget difference between HIMA and Helix Charter High School. There are many expenses that are not covered by Helix Charter High School, including instructors, clinicians, instrument maintenance and repairs, sheet music, event entry fees, hospitality, awards, and more. Without adequate donations and fundraising, we will not be able to provide the program that we offer today. To maintain our program, each family is asked to do what they are able to help meet our expenses and to participate in fundraising. This will ensure our students continue to fully experience the best program we as supporting families can offer.

We ask that each Bagpipe member's family attempt to either donate or fundraise at least \$250. Participating in donation giving (money, food, your personal time, etc.) is strictly voluntary and is not required to participate in the music program but is very much needed and appreciated. If you choose to donate, please try to do so before December because the majority of our expenses are incurred during the fall semester. Please also keep in mind that \$250 is only the beginning of covering expenses; we hope you will continue to help the program by participating in ongoing fundraisers throughout the entire school year.

A receipt of your participation in fundraisers (but not of your personal donations) can be provided to you upon your written request. State laws restrict us from tracking personal donations; however, because your personal donations may be tax deductible, please check with your tax preparer.

Marching Shoes

All band members are required to purchase their own marching shoes. Marching shoes are worn at every parade, field show, and marching band performance. Male students can also use these shoes for concert dress. The shoe that the Helix Instrumental Music Program uses is the black leather **SUPER DRILLMASTER, model #02-500**, made specifically for marching. These shoes can be purchased online at www.americanband.com for \$34.95 plus tax and shipping. **Please order as soon as possible because band members will be required to wear them on uniform fitting day, July 27, 2019.**

Uniform Undershirt, Shorts, and Socks

All band members are required to wear a black fitted t-shirt and shorts under their uniforms at all times. Compression-style clothing works well for this and shirts and shorts in both women's and men's styles with a Helix logo can be ordered at Paperwork Day. Students must also wear mid-calf-length all-black socks (no ankle socks). Please have students wear their shorts, t-shirts, socks, and shoes to uniform fitting day to facilitate trying on multiple uniform pieces in a public area.

Marching Gloves

All band members must purchase black gloves to wear during performances. These gloves often need to be replaced more than once, so we recommend buying 2 or more pairs. Black gloves will be available for purchase at Paperwork Day. Use the following guidelines depending on what instrument your student plays:

- ~All gloves must be BLACK
- ~Woodwind players must wear fingerless cotton gloves
- ~Brass players must wear Velcro closure: Sure grip gloves
- ~Upper battery/drums need Under Armour 6" wrist bands
- ~Pit members do not need gloves

Please bring gloves to uniform fitting day to be put with your student's uniform.
